# General Enhancements

- Auto save documents every 5 minutes
- 65K row limit bumped up
- Excel export
  - Handles more than 65k rows
  - Export Modes
    - Prioritize the formatting of the documents – default today
    - Prioritize easy data processing in Excel – eliminates split cells and speeds download
- Email documents
- Java tool faster and more stable



# Flexible report management

- Less web browser, more client feel
  - All documents can be viewed in 1 area
    - Eliminates leaving one area to go to another for a different report
  - Interfaces like a file manager with folders
    - Categories allowed for a second type of filing
  - Copy/Cut/Paste of documents allowed for easier management
- All current reports will be converted and available



# Robust in-line formatting/editing

- Expanded right click capabilities on report attributes.
- Drag column width changes
- Formatting significantly improved
  - Tool bars with many formatting options
    - Font, text alignment, size
    - No more need to jump back and forth to formatting page
- Variable editor available
  - Allows formulas in report without using java tool



# Ranking, Input Controls, Merging Universes

- Ranking
  - Top X or Bottom X result set
- Input Controls
  - “On the fly” filtering
    - Sliders that allow changes in filter with “slide-bars”
- Merging universe dimension objects
  - Combine 2 queries base on a common attribute
    - Create a report based on multiple queries – e.g. number of accounts created and number of downloads for a given month/year.



# New Report Functions

- Greatly expanded list of available functions including
  - runningtotal()
  - runningcount()
  - linenumber() – row count of report
  - initcap() & upper() & lower()
  - lastdayofmonth() & lastdayofweek()
  - numberofrows() & numberofpages()
